Designed for experienced controllers and covering all aspects of OJTI training.

The course equips candidates with the know-how to prepare, train, monitor, evaluate, and debrief prospective future trainees in initial qualification programmes and qualified controllers fulfilling unit competency requirements, through a combination of practical and theoretical learning methodologies.

Conducted by experienced OJTI instructors, and incorporating current ICAO training philosophies, candidates will undergo theoretical classroom and practical (simulated) exercises. Practical sessions will be conducted at Global ATS' international campus using Micro Nav's BEST Simulators, utilising generic Aerodrome, Approach, and Area Control scenarios.
