Candidates are tested using the ICAO rating scale, which contains the following six level descriptors:

- Levels 1-3: Non-Operational
- Level 4: Operational
- Level 5: Extended
- Level 6: Expert

Interviews are conducted one-to-one with the candidate to assess their ICAO-specified English Language Rating. This process can comprise of various questions, informal chats, and tests of comprehension.
